



POOL RULES - YEAR 2024

THESE RULES ARE ESTABLISHED FOR YOUR SAFETY, COMFORT, AND CONVENIENCE.
YOU MAY ENTER AND USE THESE RECREATIONAL AMENITIES AT YOUR OWN RISK
THE ASSOCIATION CANNOT GUARANTEE YOUR SAFETY FROM THE COVID-19 VIRUS
YOU MUST FOLLOW ALL CDC SAFETY GUIDELINES. THIS IS A NON-SMOKING AMENITY, NO
SMOKING OR VAPING OF ANY TYPE IS PERMITTED WITHIN THE ENTIRE POOL AREA.

The pool will open on Saturday *May 25 to Monday May 27, 2024*, for weekends only until *June 22, 2024* at which time the pool will open full time, 7 days per week.

The last day of operation will be Monday **September 2, 2024, at 7 pm.**

Open pool hours are Sunday to Saturdays

12:00 noon to 7:00 pm

*****Per NJ State Regulations the pool must be closed for a half hour
each day for the guards' lunch break*****

The pool staff and lifeguards are responsible for the safe and sanitary operation of the pool, grounds, and general conduct of members. The Pool Co. has complete authority to refuse to admit any member for health reasons, intoxication, misconduct, or other causes, and can suspend or expel any member for misconduct or disregard of rules and regulations. The pool staff may close the pool for maintenance operations, health conditions, weather or any reason deemed sufficient by the pool staff. All members and guests must observe these and any later regulations with the understanding that, should circumstances warrant, the management may cancel any membership.

RESPONSIBILITY

1. The Hunt Club Condominium Association will not be responsible for loss of jewelry, valuables, clothing, or property, in or about the pool area and grounds.
2. All residents, including children, using the Hunt Club's facilities do so at their own risk. The Hunt Club Condominium Association will not be responsible for any accidents in connection with such use.
3. The cost of any property damage caused through the negligence or carelessness of a resident will be charged to the member.

ADMISSION

No member shall be admitted to the pool without presenting a recreational pass. They will be numbered, with each number registered to the individual unit. All fees due to the Association must be paid to date to receive a permit. *This is a MUST!!* All Renters must have a current lease filed in the office before a badge will be issued.

Guests will NOT be permitted.

No child up to and including the age of sixteen (16) years of age will be permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by one of their parents or a responsible person. The responsible person must be 18 or older. No more than two children per adult will be permitted. A child will be considered to be sixteen years of age if he or she reached the age of sixteen no later than August 31 of the current swimming season. A birth certificate will be requested.

Must provide a copy of birth certificate to prove the age of 16

SAFETY AND SANITATION

No child 2 years old or under is permitted in the adult pool at any time for any reason. Our wading pool is provided for the safety and security of all small children. Parents must accompany small children while in the wading pool and must be an arm's length of small children in water to protect against rapid drowning.

1. No one is permitted in the main pool unless a lifeguard is on duty.
2. Children in the wading pool and tot lot are solely the responsibility of their parents and are not under the supervision of the lifeguards.
3. In order to prevent any accidents from occurring and ultimately closing the pool for a 24-hour period, **babies in disposable diapers or untrained will not be permitted in the wading or adult pool. Babies *MUST* wear swimming diapers**, e.g. "Little Swimmers" to use the **wading pool only**. Babies and children wearing diapers of any type are not permitted in the adult pool. This includes carrying of the baby/child in the adult pool. Any individual who does not have complete control of his/her bodily functions, must wear a swim diaper or swim pants that adequately protects from leakage (regular and cloth diapers are not allowed).
4. Non-qualified swimmers are not allowed in deep water.
5. No running, ball throwing, pushing, wrestling, dunking, rough play, etc. is permitted within the pool area.
6. All injuries, however slight, must be reported to the Pool Manager or the lifeguard.
7. Glass or glass containers are not allowed on the property. This includes baby bottles.
8. "Noodles" and kick boards are permitted but other floatation devices shall not be permitted in the main pool. Small inflatable rubber or plastic toys will be permitted in the wading pool. However, no hard or sharp items (such as metal buckets and shovels) will be permitted.
9. There will be no barbecuing permitted at any time. Food is permitted in designated areas only.
10. Female bathers must remove all bobby pins and curlers and any other hair ornaments.
11. Intoxicating beverages of any description may not be carried to or within the pool enclosure. Members may bring in non-alcoholic beverages in non-glass containers. **NO HARD SELTZER**
12. All trash must be deposited in the trash receptacles. Please use the recycle containers for any aluminum cans. Help us keep the pool area free of all refuse. **NO LITTERING.**
13. Persons suffering from communicable illnesses, skin diseases, sores or fungus infections, eye, ear, nose, or throat infections are prohibited from using the pool. The pool staff will bar from the pool any persons who, in their opinion, exhibit evidence of the above.
14. Chairs and chaise lounges are provided free for adults only. Saving or holding chairs will not be permitted. Chairs and lounges are offered on a first come, first serve basis.
15. **Radios or portable sound equipment used with headphones only will be permitted in the pool area.**
16. All persons must leave the pool when the ***ALL OUT*** whistle is sounded.
17. Use of the refrigerator, stove and/or Clubhouse is strictly prohibited.

18. Children under 13 must take a test administered by the lifeguards to swim in the deep section of the pool. Ankle bands will be issued when the test has been passed. In the event that the band is lost, a replacement can be purchased for \$1.00.
19. No clothing with offensive language or messaging.
20. The pool is not a toilet, please use the bathroom.
21. Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests.
22. Yelling, shouting and/or abusive language directed at lifeguards or other residents will not be tolerated. The pool is a commonly shared resource of enjoyment and relaxation for everyone. Treat everyone with respect, be mindful of how words and actions might impact others around you.
23. Harassment and/or threatening behavior directed at lifeguards, employees, board members, or residents will not be tolerated.
24. If any member becomes delinquent in the payment of their condo assessments and related charges after receipt of a pool pass, that member will lose his/her membership privileges, including use of the pool and all amenities. Fines of \$100 per occurrence will be imposed for each unauthorized use of the pool.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION (Cumulative)

All persons shall obey the rules outlined herein and the instructions of the lifeguard and/or Pool Staff.

Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action as outlined:

First Offense: Verbal warning

Second Offense: Suspension of Pool Privileges for a week

Third Offense: Suspension of pool privileges for the remainder of the season.

NOTE: If a situation warrants, The Hunt Club Board of Trustees, the Pool Company, supervisor/lifeguard or the Hunt Club Manager can suspend or revoke pool privileges without following the above course of action.

NOTE: Any owner that has outstanding balance/fines cannot use another owners pool passes to enter pool

***This is a family pool so proper swim wear is required**
